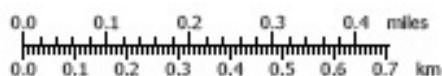
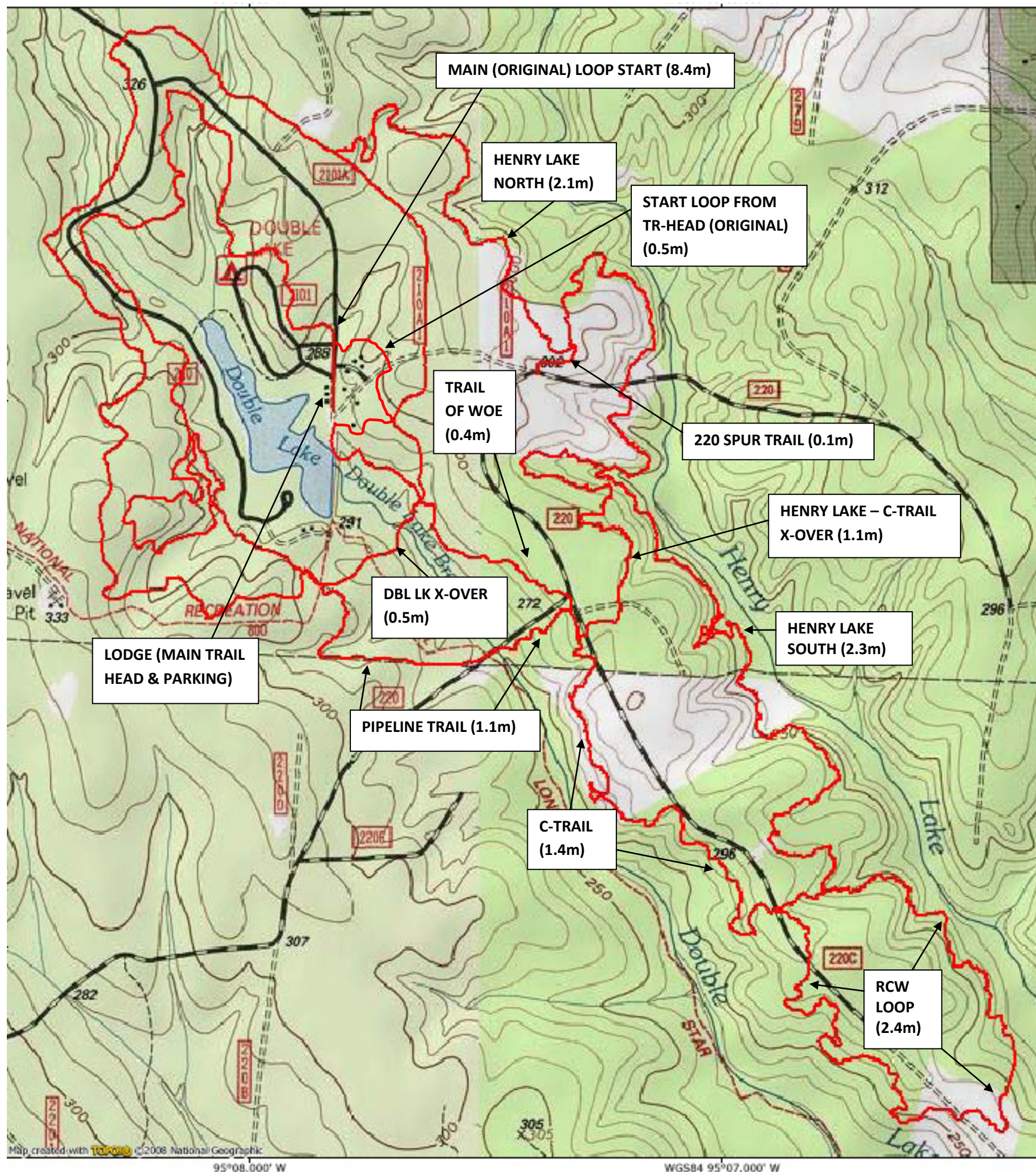


## DOUBLE LAKE COMPLETED EXPANSION & TRAIL NAMES – DEC 2010

The Double Lake Expansion is now complete, save for a few minor adjustments to be completed in January 2011. This map shows the final trail layout. The original loop of 8.4 miles is at the North West corner of the system and the expansion comprises two main trails running parallel to Double Lake and Henry Lake Creeks and Forest Road 220C – named “HENRY LAKE” and “C” trails. There are three main connections from the old to the new – the “Trail of Woe”, “Pipeline Trail” and “Henry Lake North” meeting the old loop “Home-stretch”. There are two crossovers between the main trails and then at the South-Eastern end of the system is the “RCW Loop” (named for the Red Cockaded Woodpecker). Part of the original loop is the “Double Lake Cross-Over” (DL-CX) which has been repaired and offers additional loop options. You may also use the Forest Roads 220 and 220C for further loop options, or a quicker return to base. Temporary signage is now installed.



### NOTES:

1. Take note of Hunting Season dates – typically Nov 25<sup>th</sup> – Jan 2<sup>nd</sup>. Wear bright clothing and stay off the trail near Dawn/Dusk in this period.
2. The trail is off-limits to motorized vehicles and horses. Report misuse to the Forest Service – 936 344 6205.
3. Stay off the Lone Star Trail on your bike. You will cross it several times – it is marked and is restricted to Pedestrian traffic only.
4. Trails are 2-way – call out at blind corners. Normal trail rules apply: Be nice! Stay off wet trails.
5. You are in the Sam Houston National Forest. It is a beautiful place – stop and take a look and appreciate it. Leave no trace (especially goo packs and empty bottles!!).
